Professor Sarah Gilbert is Professor of Vaccinology at Nuffield Department of Medicine, the University of Oxford, UK and co-founder of Vaccitech.

Professor Gilbert specialises in the development of vaccines against influenza and emerging viral pathogens. Her team helped lead the development of the Oxford University/AstraZeneca ChAdOX1 nCoV-19 vaccine.
